Dr. Cha-oncin Sooksriwong is an associate professor at the Department of Pharmacy Practice, Faculty of Pharmacy, Thammasart University. She retired from the Division of Social and Administrative Pharmacy, Department of Pharmacy, Mahidol University in 2017.

Since her graduation, she has taught in Pharmacy Administration, Pharmacy and Health System, and Health Policy. Her research area is drug system and policy focusing on drug prices and logistics.
